Specification of the intended use or limitations

The intended use of this product is for making coffee or tea.

The product is suitable for following food/ drink: Coffee, tea, and water.

The jar and water tank are not suitable for freezer or microwave oven.

Time, temperature, and storage in contact with food/ drink is:

- a) Time, up to 40 minutes.
- b) Temperature, up to 85 degrees in jar.
- c) Grinded coffee in filter is recommended not to be stored there for more than 5 hours.
- d) Coffee in the jar is recommended not to be stored there for more than 40 minutes.

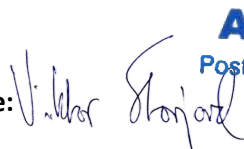
